VIEWS ON SALVATION

Pluralism

The belief that more than Christianity, (possibly even all religions) are equally true and able to save a person.

Inclusivism

The belief that salvation is by Christ but that persons of other religions are saved through Christ despite their lack of repentance or belief in Christ.

Exclusivism

"There is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."
-Acts 4:12

ROMANS 5

Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. 2 Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

ROMANS 5

12 Therefore, just as sin came into the world through one man, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men because all sinned— 13 for sin indeed was in the world before the law was given, but sin is not counted where there is no law. 14 Yet death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over those whose sinning was not like the transgression of Adam, who was a type of the one who was to come.



ROMANS 5

15 But the free gift is not like the trespass. For if many died through one man's trespass, much more have the grace of God and the free gift by the grace of that one man Jesus Christ abounded for many. 16 And the free gift is not like the result of that one man's sin. For the judgment following one trespass brought condemnation, but the free gift following many trespasses brought justification.



ROMANS 5

17 For if, because of one man's trespass, death reigned through that one man, much more will those who receive the abundance of grace and the free gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man Jesus Christ.

18 Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men.

ROMANS 5

19 For as by the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the one man's obedience the many will be made righteous. 20 Now the law came in to increase the trespass, but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more, 21 so that, as sin reigned in death, grace also might reign through righteousness leading to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

God's Curse On the Serpent

"I will put enmity between you and the woman, and \square between your offspring and her offspring; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel"

-Genesis 3:14-15

Satan seeks to disrupt genealogy through death and corruption. He fails, because Christ still comes to redeem sinners and destroy Satan.

Seed of Woman Genealogy:

- Eve
- Seth
- Noah
- Shem (Genesis 9:26)
- Abraham (Genesis 12:3)
- Isaac (Genesis 26:3)
- Jacob (Genesis 35:11–12)
- Judah (Genesis 49:10)
- David (2 Samuel 7:12–16)
- Zerubbabel (Haggai 2:23)
- This is why the New Testament begins with Jesus genealogy from Abraham to Mary and Joseph (Mathew 1).

CHRIST IS THE FULFILLMENT OF MULTIPLE OTHER PROPHECIES

- Born in Bethlehem (Micah 5:2)
- Come before the Temple is destroyed (AD 70; Daniel 9:24–26).
- Born of a Virgin (Isaiah 7:14 Matthew 1:22-23, Luke 1:26-31)
- Children would be massacred at his birthplace (Jeremiah 31:15, Matthew 2:16-18)
- His side would be pierced (Zechariah 12:10, John 19:34)
- (Jesus fulfills over 40 Messianic prophecies)

In the Book *Science Speaks*, Peter Stoner and Robert Newman address the statistical improbability of one man fulfilling only eight of the prophecies Jesus fulfilled. The chance of this happening is 1 in 10 to the 17th power.

THE WHOLE OF SCRIPTURE POINTS TO CHRIST

- God sacrificed an animal to create covering for Adam and Eve (Genesis 3:21) foreshadowing Christ's sacrifice to cover our sin.
- Able's acceptable sacrifice.
- God saves Noah and his family IN the ark foreshadowing salvation IN Christ. (Genesis 7:23)
- Abraham is to sacrifice his son but God provides a substitute (Gen. 22:8-13)
- The Passover foreshadows Christ (Exodus 12)
- God provides manna in the wilderness as Jesus would offer His body as the bread of life (Exodus 16:35)
- God dwelt in the temple until Jesus atonement when the veil was torn in two (Exodus 29:43, Matthew 27:51)
- Moses interceded for Israel on their behalf, though they deserved destruction. (Exodus 32:11)

THE WHOLE OF SCRIPTURE POINTS TO CHRIST

- Jesus is raised up so that people may look on him and live as with the bronze serpent on the pole in the Old Testament (Numbers 21:8, John 3:13-15)
- Jonah is in the belly of the fish for 3 days (Jonah 1:17)
- Melchizedek is a priest king foreshadowing Christ (Isaiah 9:6, Acts 3:15.)
- Wisdom literature (Job, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes) points us to the need for Christ (Colossians 2:3).
- Prophecy (Isaiah, Jeremiah, and Ezekiel)
- God promises to dwell with His people (Leviticus 26:11-12; Ezekiel 37:26-28), something fulfilled in the incarnation (John 1:14) and the future kingdom of Christ (Revelation 21:3).



SALVATION IS IN CHRIST ALONE

- **God's Word Says So Clearly (John 14:6, Acts 4:12)**
- **All of Scripture Points to Christ (Foreshadowing, Prophecies, Archetypes, etc).**
- **Jesus is the only "Second Adam" (Romans 5)**
- **Jesus is the "Seed of Woman" (Mark 10:45, Gen. 3)**
- **To deny the Son is to be under wrath (John 3:36)**
- **We are not saved by works of the law (Gal. 2:15-16)**
- **Christ is the only Mediator (1 Tim 2:5)**
- **The very First commandment (Exodus 20:3)**
- **God calls word religions to repent (Acts 17)**
